

# REIGN FC DEFEATS ANGEL CITY 2-0 ON PRIDE NIGHT AT LUMEN FIELD

Club original Jess Fishlock nets game-winning goal in the second half; Goalkeeper Claudia Dickey earns fourth shutout of the season to extend unbeaten streak to four games

**SEATTLE, WASH.** (August 1, 2025) — Seattle Reign FC (7-4-3, 24 points) earned a 2-0 victory over Angel City FC (4-7-3, 15 points) on Friday night at Lumen Field in front of a single-season high crowd during the club's annual Pride Match, presented by The Starbucks Coffee Company.

After a scoreless first half, Reign original Jess Fishlock broke the deadlock in the 66<sup>th</sup> minute, scoring the game-winner after entering the match as a second-half substitute. Reign FC doubled their lead in the 86<sup>th</sup> minute, when defender Sofia Huerta's in-swinging corner was flicked on by Fishlock and deflected into the net by Angel City's Alanna Kennedy for an own goal. The night also marked the NWSL debut of forward Mia Fishel, who entered in the 81<sup>st</sup> minute. Goalkeeper Claudia Dickey recorded her fourth clean sheet of the year, setting a new single-season career high and helping extend Reign FC's unbeaten run to four matches.

Seattle returns to action on Sunday, August 10 (1:00 p.m. CBS / Paramount+), traveling south to face rivals Portland Thorns FC at Providence Park. The two sides last met in a friendly in on July 26, with the Reign earning a win in a sudden death shootout.

# MATCH NOTES

- ROLLING REIGN: After going unbeaten in three straight road matches during June, Reign FC extended its streak to four with Friday night's 2-0 win over Angel City FC. The match marked the club's first regular season home appearance since May 23.
- CLAUDIA DICKEY: Claudia Dickey tallied a season-high six saves and earned her fourth shutout of the year – setting a new single-season career best. The 25-yearold now has 10 career clean sheets and 123 saves across four NWSL seasons.
- **MIA FISHEL:** Mia Fishel, who signed with the club on July 10, made her NWSL debut as a substitute in the 81<sup>st</sup> minute.



- **JESS FISHLOCK:** Club original Jess Fishlock opened the scoring in the 66<sup>th</sup> minute, notching her second goal of the season. The Welsh midfielder now has 44 career regular-season goals, tying Portland Thorns FC's Sophia Wilson for 11<sup>th</sup>-most in NWSL history.
- **SERIES:** With tonight's result, Reign FC holds a record of 9-3-1 against Angel City FC across all NWSL competitions.
- **UP NEXT:** Reign FC (7-4-2, 24 points) will return to Providence Park to play rival club Portland Thorns FC (6-3-4, 22 points) on Sunday, August 10 (1:00 p.m. CBS / Paramount+).
