

HOUSTON DASH GAME NOTES

HOUSTON DASH HEAD WEST TO FACE SEATTLE REIGN FC

The Houston Dash travel to Lumen Field on Sunday, May 11 to face Seattle Reign FC at 7 p.m. CT. The Dash are 1-1-0 (WLD) on the road this season and look for their first victory in Seattle since the 2022 season. Both teams split the regular season series in 2024 with each team winning at home.

The Dash closed a two-game homestand with a 2-1 loss to Racing Louisville FC last Friday evening. Defender Avery Patterson scored in the ninth minute to give Houston the lead and that was her first goal of the season. Patterson scored her first goal as a professional during her rookie season against Bay FC at home on Nov. 2, 2024.

Forward Ryan Gareis tallied her second assist of the season on the play. Gareis led the team with seven crosses against Louisville and Patterson finished with four shots on target.

Forward Yazmeen Ryan led the team with three chances created against Louisville and finished with three touches inside the opponent's box. Ryan led the team with eight duels won and finished with three recoveries. Midfielder Delanie Sheehan led the team with seven recoveries and the midfielder created one chance last Friday.

Defensively, Dash captain Jane Campbell finished with three saves against Louisville. She currently leads the league with 23 saves this season. Defender Paige Nielsen earned her 100th start in league play and she finished with four clearances in the match. Defender Katie Lind led the team with six clearances.

Friday' match marked the return of forward Evelina Duljan and defender Natalie Jacobs who both missed the last three matches due to injury. Jacobs created one chance and finished with one recovery in her second half shift. Duljan finished with a shot and helped on the defensive side of the ball with a tackle won.

Seattle Reign FC opened a two-game homestand with a 1-0 victory over the Kansas City Current on Friday evening. Lynn Biyendolo scored the lone goal of the match in the 37th minute and that was her first goal of the season. Jordyn Huitema tallied the assist on the goal and that was her first of the regular season. Seattle currently sits in fifth place in the league standings and has won two out of their last three games.

Friday's shutout was the second clean sheet of the season for Claudia Dickey, who boasts a 0.86 goals-against average and that ranks amongst the lowest in the league. To date, Seattle has only allowed more than one goal in one match, a 2-1 loss on the road to Angel City FC on March 30.

Seattle will visit Shell Energy Stadium on Sunday, Aug. 24 for the second match of the regular season series.

The Dash return to Shell Energy Stadium on Friday, May 16 to host Deyna Castellanos and Portland Thorns FC. Tickets for that match are available on SeatGeek.

ANGELA HUCLES MANGANO
HOUSTON DASH PRESIDENT OF SOCCER

Angela Hucles Mangano was hired as President of Women's Soccer on December 9 and is the first individual to serve in this role. Hucles Mangano serves as the Chief Soccer Officer for the team and brings nearly four decades of experience in the sports industry as an executive, motivational speaker and athlete.

Hucles Mangano most recently served as the General Manager for Angel City FC. She joined the Angel City technical staff in 2021 as the Vice President of Player Development and Operations. Hucles Mangano was promoted to general manager the following year and built a roster that earned Angel City's first ever playoff appearance in 2023. She led all aspects of soccer operations for the club and earlier this year she helped the organization secure a nine-acre site to house its performance center starting in 2025.

Her experience in the non-profit sector includes a two-year stint with Up2Us Sports as a Regional Director. She has also served on the board of non-profit organizations like You Can Play, which is dedicated to fostering a safe and inclusive environment for all who participate in sports, including LGBTQ+ athletes, coaches and fans.

Hucles Mangano is a two-time Olympic gold medal winner with the U.S. Women's National Team and appeared in more than 100 matches for the United States. She also joined the USWNT for the 2003 and 2007 FIFA Women's World Cups, earning two bronze medals. Her professional career began in Virginia where she played for the Hampton Roads Piranhas of the W-League for one season. She spent the next nine seasons in Boston playing for the Boston Breakers, both in the WUSA and WPS professional soccer leagues, and Boston Renegades.

Following her retirement from professional soccer, the Virginia Beach, Virginia native also spent time as a commentator for ESPN, NBC and FOX during their coverage of international events like the Olympic Games and FIFA Women's World Cup.



FABRICE GAUTRAT HOUSTON DASH HEAD COACH

Gautrat enters his first season as the head coach of the Houston Dash and brings extensive NWSL playoff experience and more than 15 years of coaching experience at the professional and youth levels.

Gautrat joins the Dash following two seasons with the North Carolina Courage as an assistant coach. The 37-year-old helped North Carolina reach the postseason in back-to-back campaigns and win the 2023 NWSL Challenge Cup. The team also reached the semifinals of the NWSL x LIGA MX Femenil Summer Cup.

The Santa Clarita, Calif. native began his NWSL coaching career with the Chicago Red Stars in 2020 as an assistant coach. The team reached the final of the inaugural NWSL Challenge Cup in 2020 and qualified for

the postseason in back-to-back seasons following the return of league play in 2021. Gautrat also helped the team reach the 2021 NWSL Championship.

Gautrat brings extensive youth coaching experience following his time with Chicago FC United in Illinois, where he served as the academy director and led the transformation of the club into a nationally ranked program with multiple playoff appearances. He joined the club in 2018 as the head coach of the U-14 and U-19 teams and left in February 2022 to join the Red Stars full-time. During his time with FC United he also joined the U.S. U-17 Youth National Team camp in June 2019.

His experience includes a stint in France with Olympique Lyonnais in 2018 as an assistant coach for the U-19 women's and U-16 boy's squads. He also served as the director of coaching and academy director for Rush Soccer from 2015-2017 in Georgia. Gautrat began his coaching career at the prep level in 2008 in France and held various roles at Flintridge Prep and FC Golden State from 2010-2014.

Gautrat played professional soccer in the United States and France. He began his professional career in 2011 when he moved to France to play for UJA Maccabi. He played as a defender throughout his career and returned to the United States in 2014 to sign with the Orange County Blues. He finished his professional career in 2015 with the Atlanta Silverbacks of the NASL.







ABOUT SHELL ENERGY STADIUM



Shell Energy Stadium is a state-of-the-art, open-air stadium designed to host Houston Dynamo FC matches, Houston Dash matches and Texas Southern University football games as well as additional professional, collegiate and community sporting events, concerts, exhibitions, conventions and special events. Opened on May 12, 2012, the 340,000-square foot, 21,000-seat stadium is the first soccer-specific stadium in Major League Soccer located in a city's downtown district.

An architecturally stunning building, the stadium features 94,000 square feet of aluminum panels on its exterior, giving it a modern and stylish appearance. Each of the panels is 50 percent open to improve air flow throughout the concourses. Canopies extend 75 feet over the stands on the east and west sides of the stadium, and a stage canopy extends 125 feet over the south end, providing shade to soccer fans and a built-in speaker setup for concerts. With its downtown location, the stadium is a part of a true 'Stadium District,' which includes Minute Maid Park and the Toyota Center, as well as the George R. Brown Convention Center, Discovery Green, Warehouse Live and House of Blues.

The stadium was awarded the LEED® Silver certification from the U.S. Green Building Council in December 2012. The venue has been identified as a pioneering example of new construction and sustainable design and is considered a leader in transforming the building industry.

On June 13, 2019, the stadium was offically renamed from BBVA Compass Stadium to BBVA Stadium. The new stadium name and corresponding signage change was part of BBVA's ongoing brand unification happening across the globe. BBVA Group's new logo and brand signals an advancement in the financial institution's efforts become a single, global digital entity in all areas where it operates. The stadium was again renamed again in 2021 following the merger of PNC Bank and the U.S. division of BBVA.

The venue reopened its doors as Shell Energy Stadium in 2023 following an agreement between Houston Dynamo Football Club and Shell Energy. Both organizations are pursuing a variety of integrated energy and decarbonization solutions at the stadium, while also collaborating on important community initiatives. This includes a near-term goal to reduce the Club's scope one and scope two greenhouse gas emissions by 50 percent by 2026 from a 2018 base year.
