SPORTING DIRECTOR, GENERAL MANAGER - CAMILLE ASHTON

Camille Ashton is the Sporting Director and General Manager of the San Diego Wave FC, where she oversees roster construction, recruitment and the overall sporting strategy. Joining the Wave after serving as the General Manager of the Kansas City Current, where she helped the squad reach the 2022 NWSL Championship. A former professional player and Stanford University national champion, Ashton brings both playing and executive experience into her role. She continues to shape the Wave's roster.

HEAD COACH - JONAS EIDEVALL

Jonas Eidevall is in his second season as head coach of San Diego Wave FC. Before joining the Wave, he led Arsenal Women in the FA Women's Super League, winning back-to-back FA League Cup titles and reaching the UEFA Women's Champions League semifinals. Since arriving in San Diego, Eidevall has introduced a high-tempo, possession-based style and continued to emphasize player development and structure. In his first season in the NWSL, Eidevall was named Coach of the Month in April and May of 2025 and led the Club to a World Sevens Championship in December. Previously, Eidevall also won multiple league titles with FC Rosengård in Sweden, adding to his track record of success across Europe.

ASSISTANT COACH - BECKI TWEED

Becki Tweed, from Bristol, England is in her second season with Wave FC as an assistant coach to Eidevall. Tweed previously spent two seasons with Angel City FC serving as head coach, interim head coach and assistant coach from 2023-2024. During her time as interim head coach, she led an 11-game unbeaten run and guided the club to its first ever playoff appearance. Prior to Angel City, Tweed was an assistant coach with Gotham FC, helping the team reach the 2021 season playoffs. As a former professional midfielder in England and the U.S., she is currently pursuing her USSF Pro license.

ASSISTANT COACH - NATALIE HENDERSON

Natalie Henderson, a native from Newcastle, England joins San Diego Wave FC as an assistant coach for the 2026 season. Henderson brings youth development experience to the team. She most recently served as an assistant coach of Canada's Women's National team and led England's U-17 Women's national team, overseeing the development of the top youth talent, guiding players through major UEFA and FIFA competitions. Henderson also worked as lead Phase Coach within Newcastle's academy system, helping elite level prospects and earned the premier leagues Eamonn Donnan Award after becoming the first coach in a Premier League Academy Environment.

HEAD OF GOALKEEPING - JASON BATTY

Jason Batty has joined San Diego Wave as the Head of Goalkeeping, bringing extensive experience developing goalkeepers at both the international and professional levels. He has worked in major tournaments such as the FIFA Women's World Cup and Olympic Games. Born in New Zealand, Batty played professionally as a goalkeeper during his own career before moving into coaching. Known for his modern detail focus approach he has a strong reputation for improving technical skills and overall performances in elite environments.

TECHNICAL DIRECTOR - CHRIS LOXSTON

Loxston serves as the technical director of San Diego Wave FC. He joined the Wave at the start of 2023 as a Tactical Coach and last year served as the Director of Recruitment working with Ashton to bring many of the new incoming players in 2025 to the Wave. Prior to joining the Wave, Loxston built and led the performance insights team at FIFA over a five-year period. Working with renowned technical experts from around the World, Loxston was part of the group who awarded the golden boot, ball and glove at all Men's and Women's senior and junior World Cup's. Loxston also spearheaded the creation of the FIFA Football Language which has become a blueprint for football analysis around the world today. Loxston brings nearly two decades of experience in elite soccer environments to the Wave.



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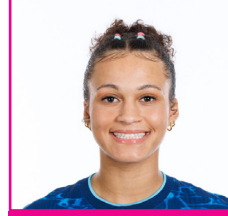

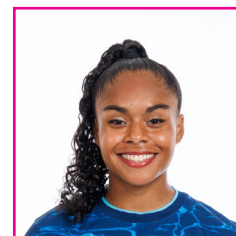

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HEAD COACH JONAS EIDEVALL



San Diego Wave FC announced on Jan. 7, 2025 that Jonas Eidevall will be the Club's new head coach. Eidevall is the second full-time head coach in Club history.

Eidevall, 41, brings more than a decade of head coaching experience and an impressive track record of success at the club level. Most recently, Eidevall managed Arsenal Women, where he led the club to three consecutive top-three finishes in the Women's Super League (WSL). During his tenure, Arsenal won back-to-back FA Women's League Cup titles (2023, 2024) and reached the semifinals of the UEFA Women's Champions League (2023), marking the club's best European performance in a decade.

Over his three seasons at Arsenal, Eidevall went 80-18-22 across all competitions, making him the winningest manager in the club's history. Under his leadership, Arsenal scored 242 goals and conceded just 97 during his tenure.

Before joining Arsenal, Eidevall led FC Rosengård in the Swedish Damallsvenskan, managing the team in two separate stints (2013-14, 2018-21). With Rosengård, he won three league titles (2013, 2019, 2020) and the Svenska Cupen Damer championship (2018). Eidevall also helped the club advance to the quarterfinals of the UEFA Women's Champions League in 2020.

Eidevall began his coaching career as an assistant at Lunds BK in Sweden before becoming head coach of the club. He then transitioned to assistant roles at FC Rosengård before being promoted to head coach.
